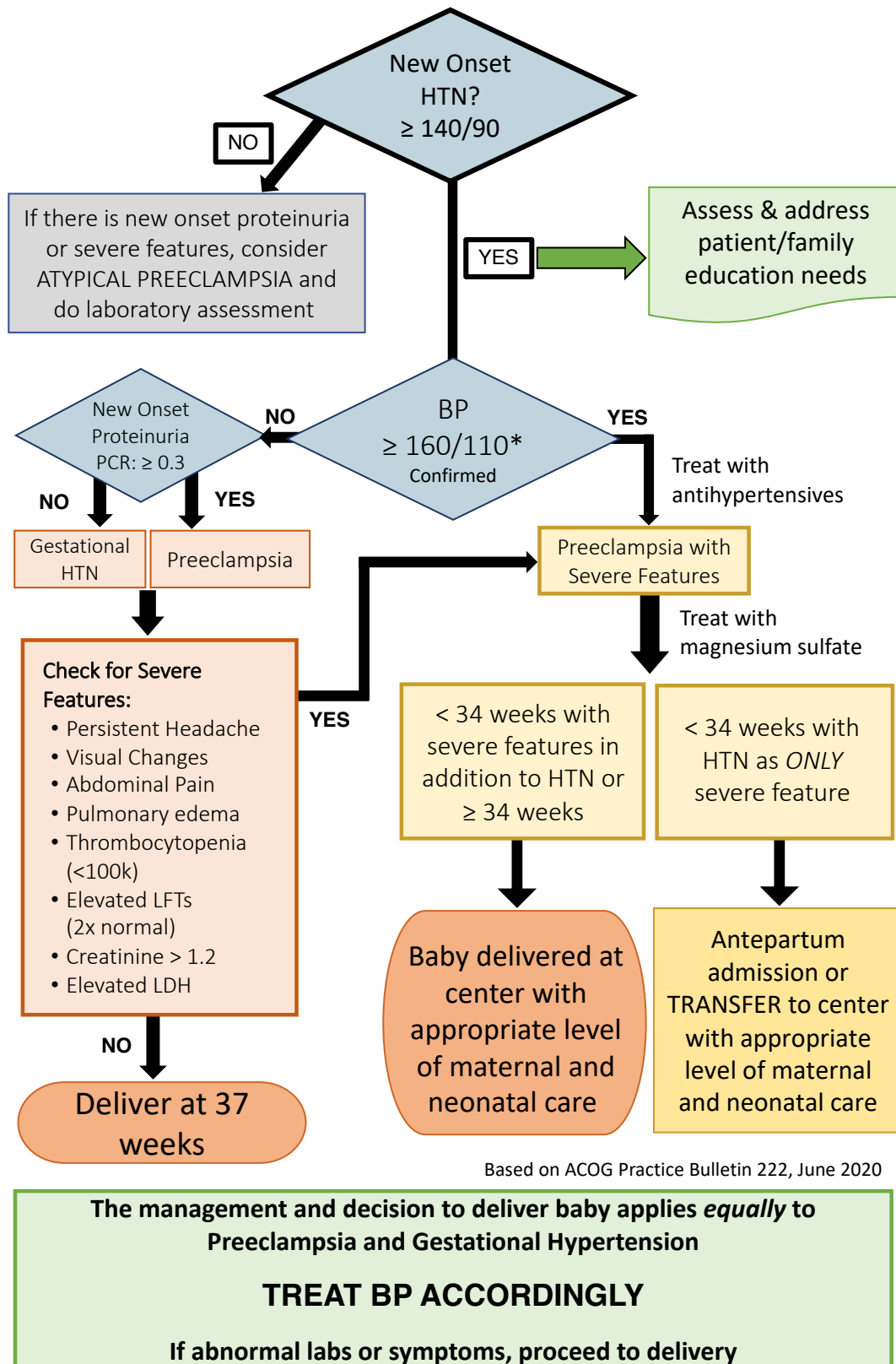


Appendix B: Suspected Preeclampsia Algorithm
